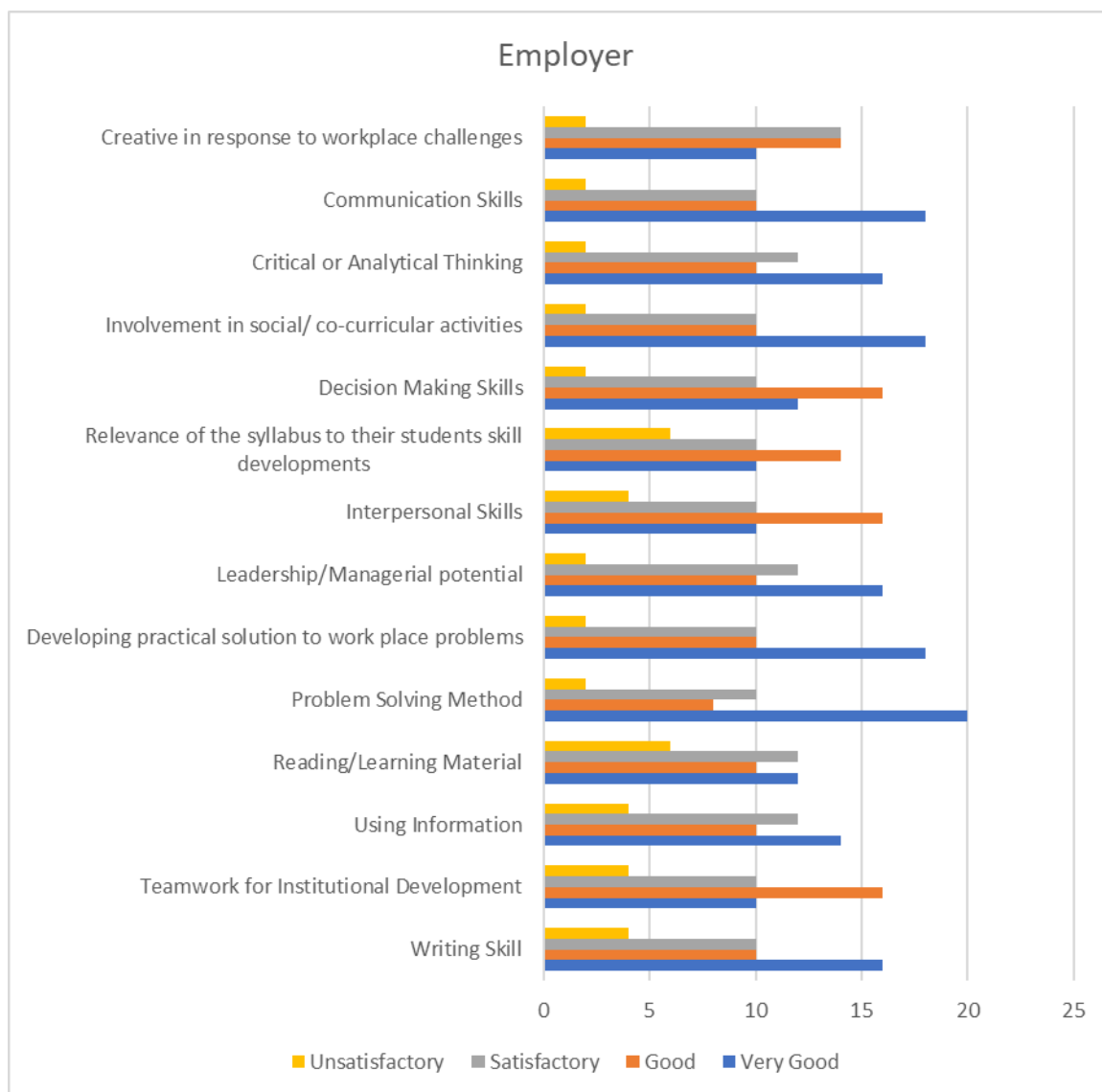

The feedback from consist of 14 items covering various aspect of students' personalities and syllabus of the course. The opinion is given through 4-point Likert scale where the scale is divided into Four points from 4 to 1. (*4 Very Good, 3 Good, 2 Satisfactory and 1 Unsatisfactory*).

In the year 2022-23 the employers were asked to give their opinion on 14 different aspects assigning each item a score from 4 to 1. After analysing the entire feedback received from the employers 'average scores were calculated'.


Following bar charts presents a summary of feedback for each item from the employers and the average scores are given in the next table and pie chart.



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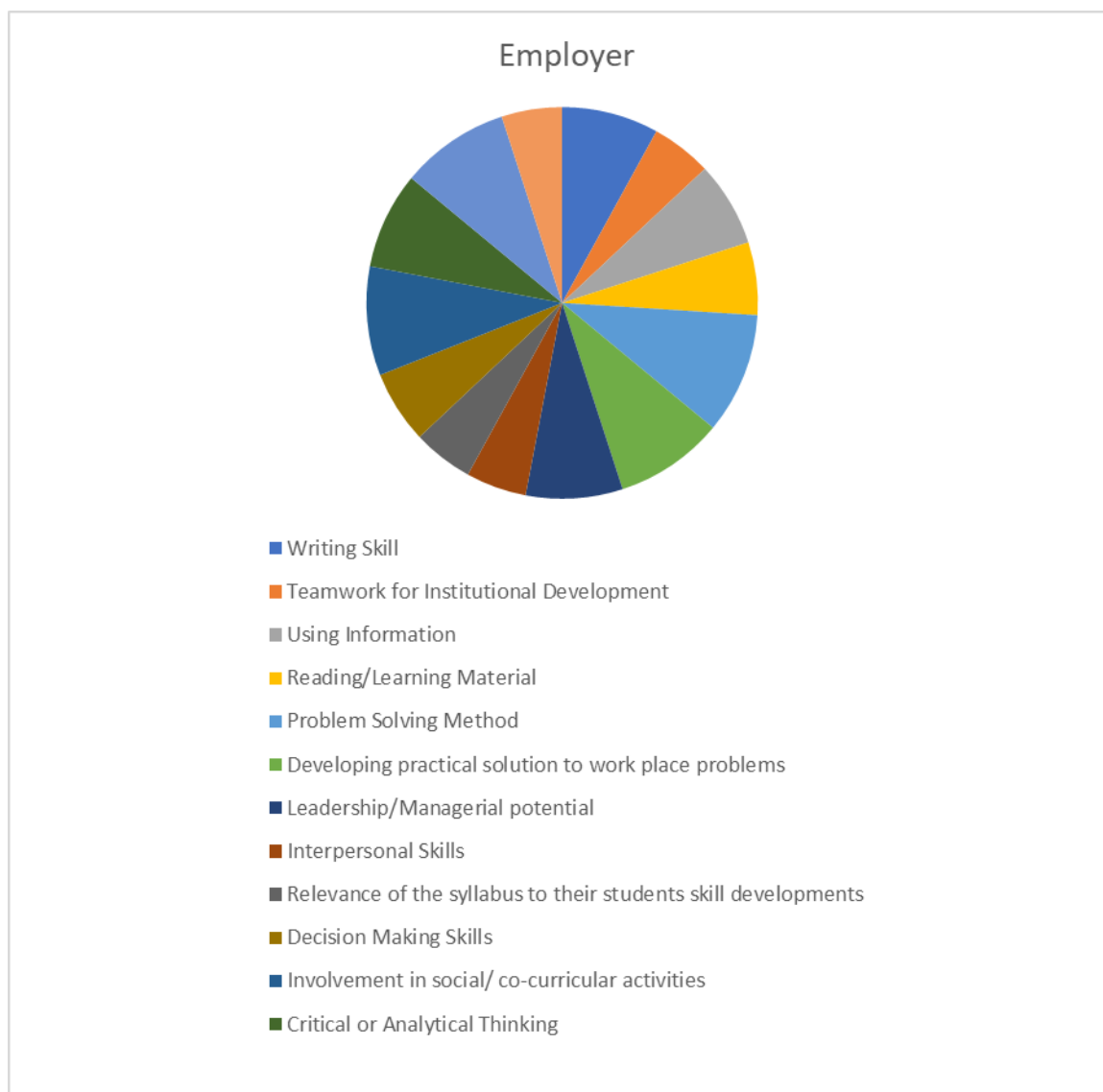

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In the year 2022-23 Bhuvan Malti Teachers Training College, Motihari conducted a survey among different employers' and received feedback from them. It can be observed from the above table that the employers have given the highest score of 3.95 to "Communication Skills" by 3.80 to "Problem Solving Method" Whereas a lowest score of 3.02 to "Creative in response to workplace challenges" and then 3.03 "Using Information" that means in the opinion of employers, college is doing well in those areas where as rank is high and college has to make more efforts for the areas where the score is low. The average score 3.36 as an overall performance of the students of BMTTC this score shows that the employers are highly satisfied with the BMCE student but some score is still there to improve upon.

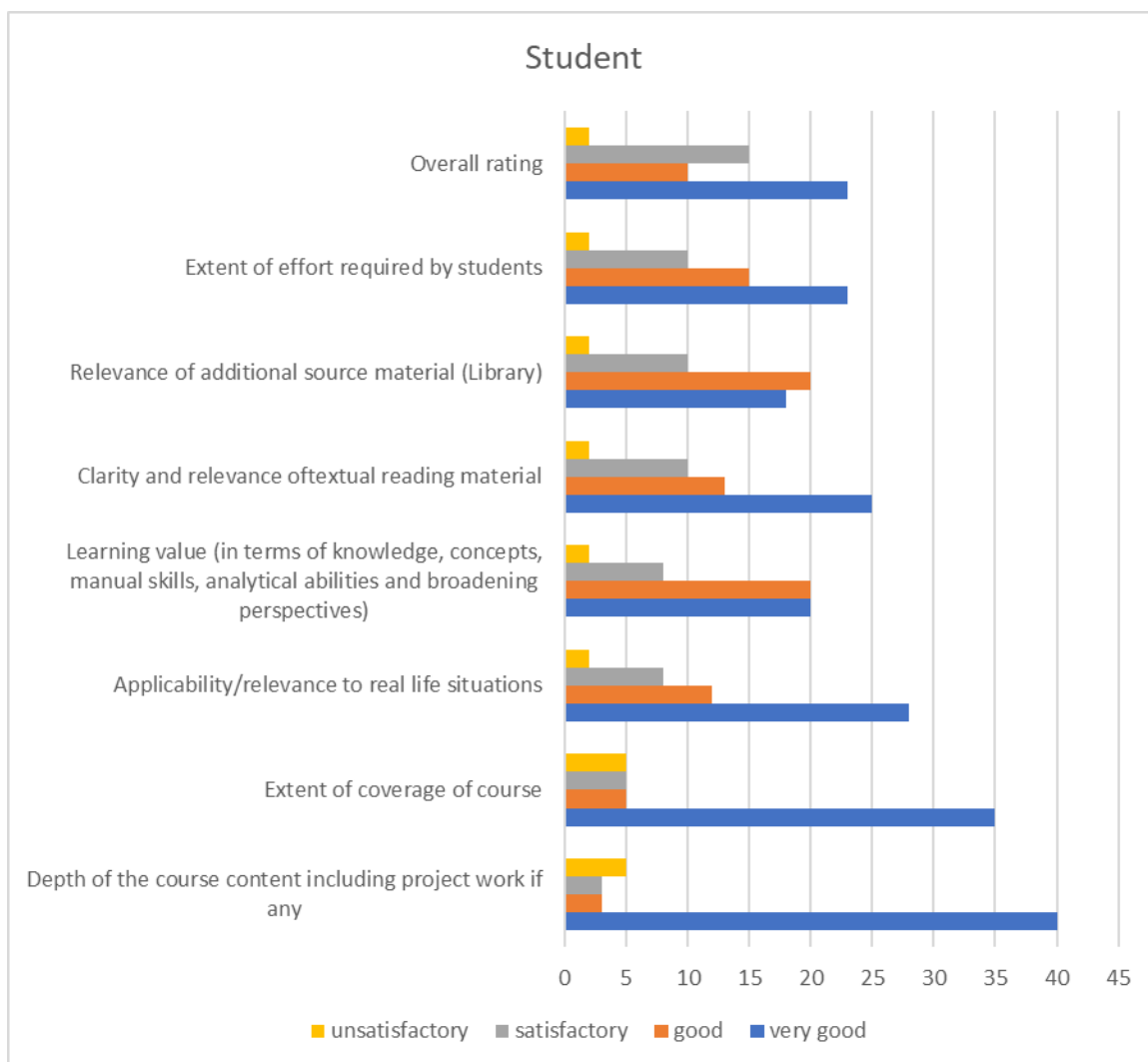

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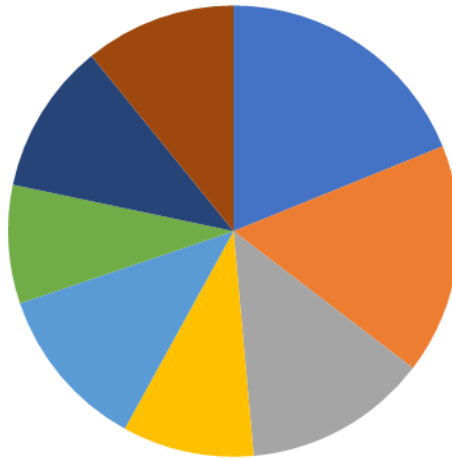

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The observations made through this feedback were like they have scored highest score of 3.98 “Relevance of additional source material (Library)” followed by 3.88 to “Clarity and relevance of textual reading material” on the other hand they have scored lowest 3.02 to “Extent of coverage of course” and then 3.10 to “Learning value (in terms of knowledge, concepts, manual skills, analytical abilities and broadening perspectives)”. The average score received from Student for this feedback is 3.37. The score shows that the student are satisfied giving this feedback.


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Alumni Feedback

Alumni are also of the stakeholders of an educational institution. They are the former students who have spent two years of their life in the college and the work then working as professional somewhere their opinion about the college and course curriculum is very- very important.

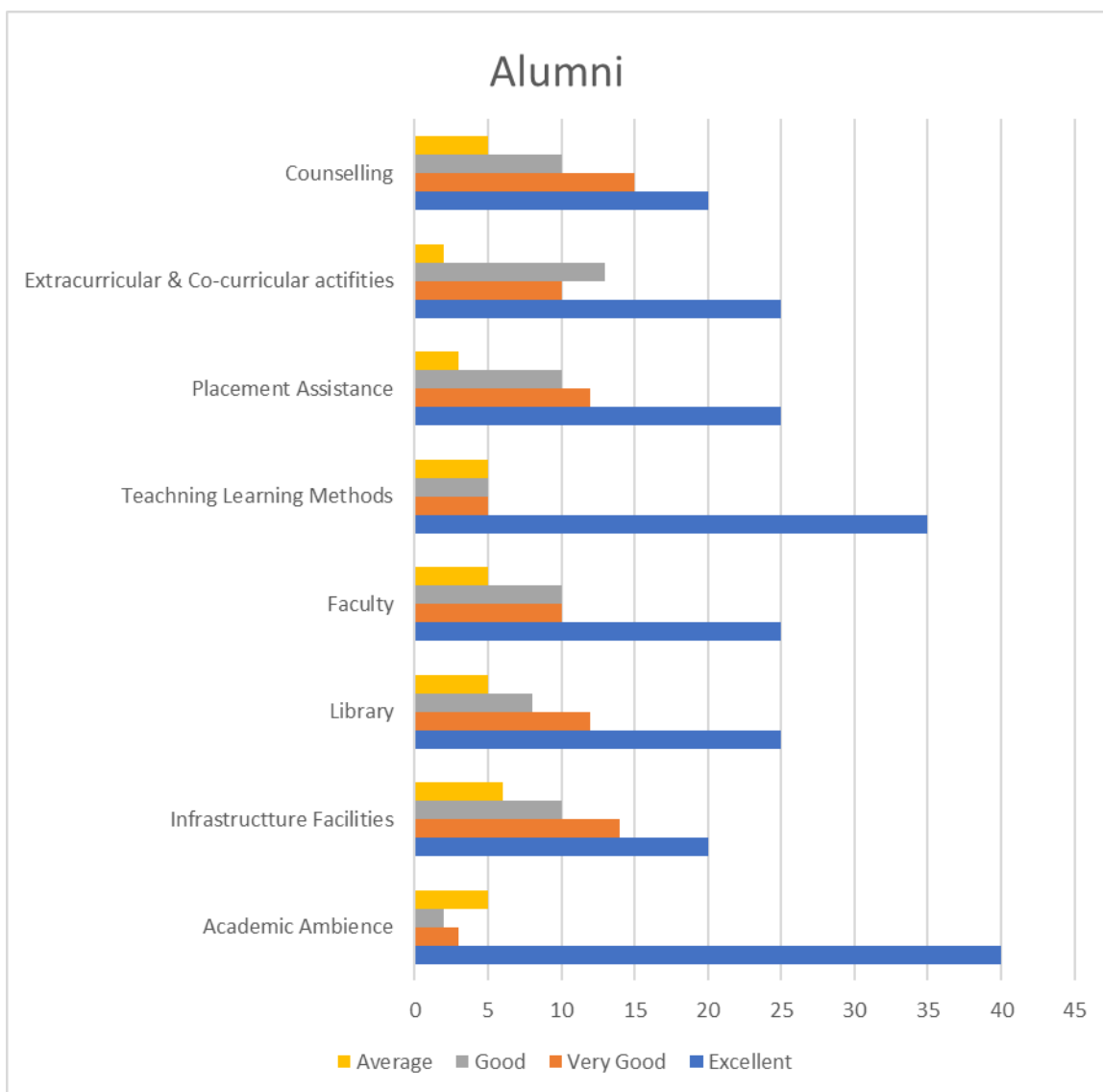

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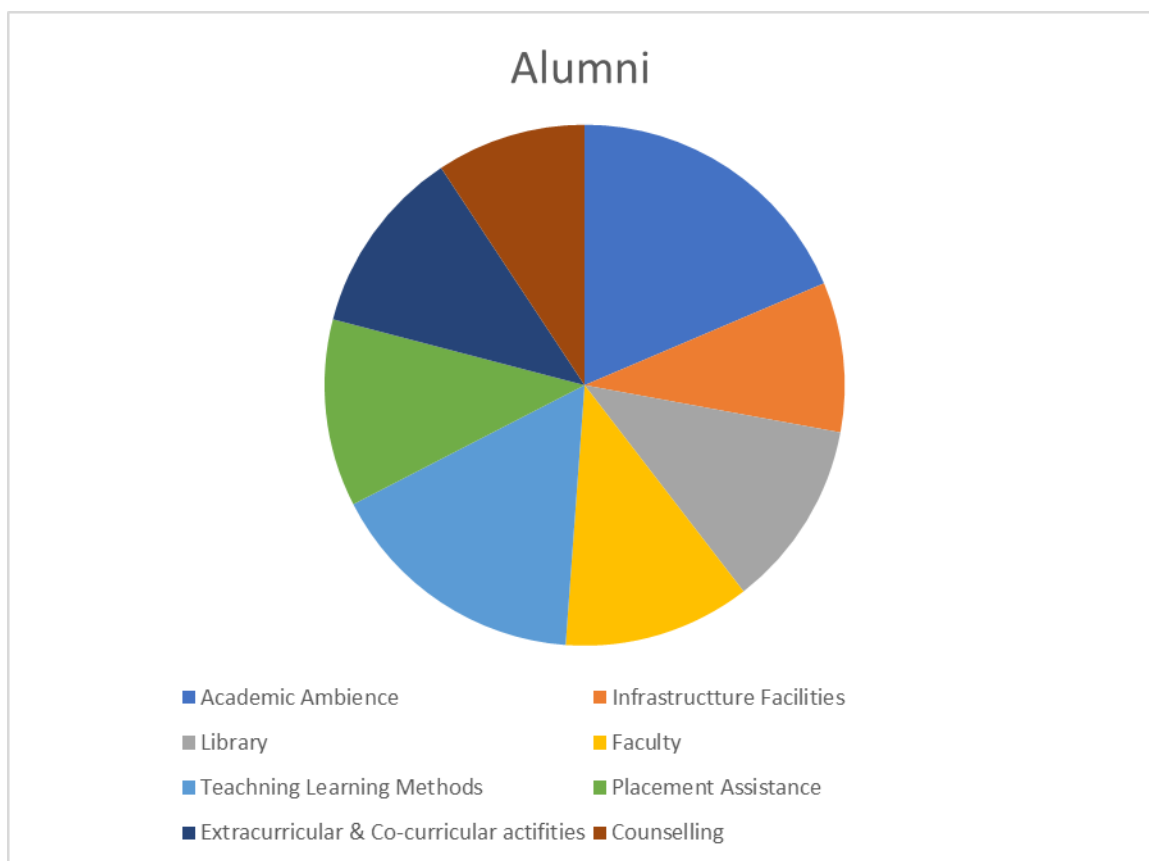

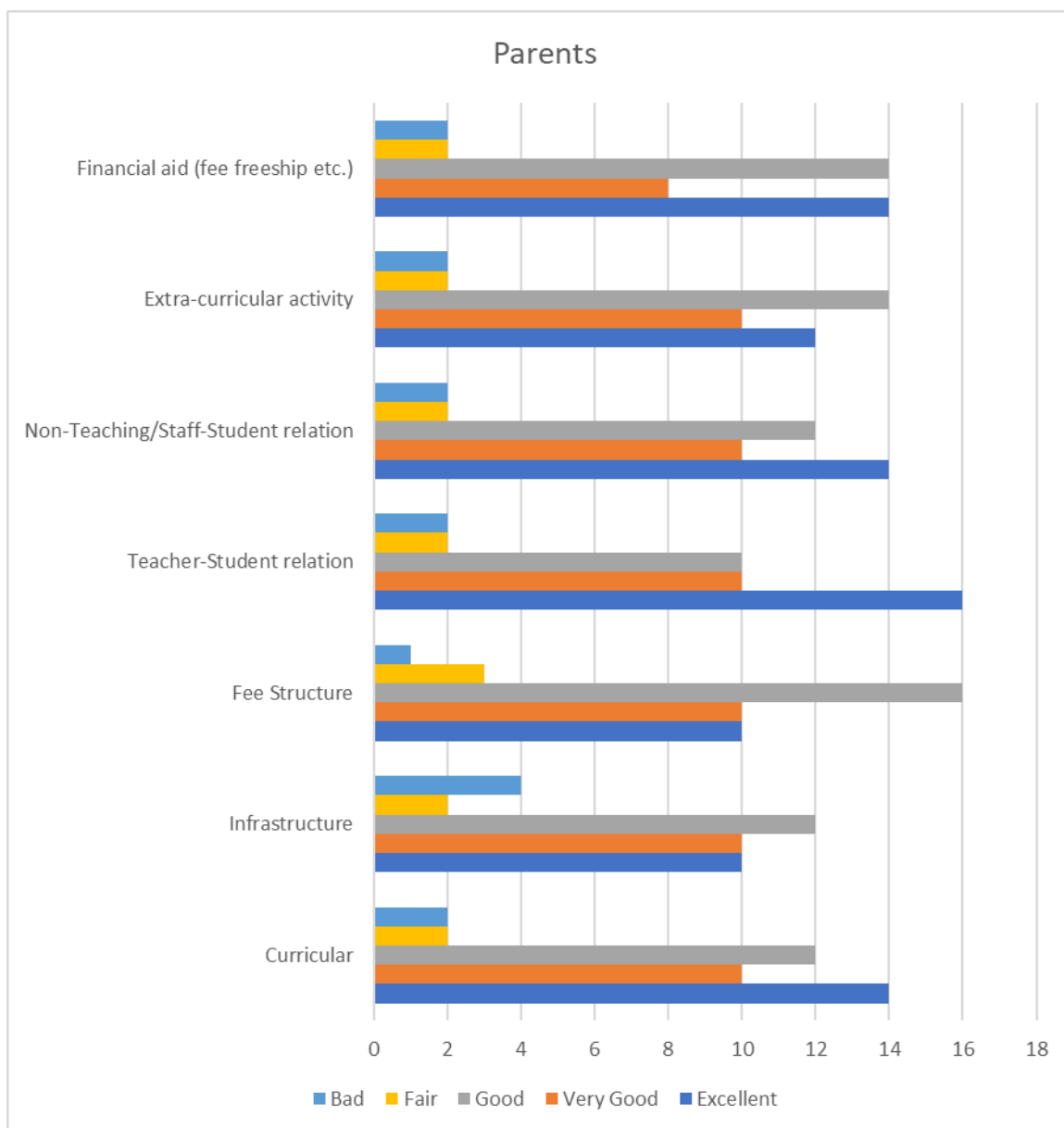

Following bar chart parents a summary of feedback for each item from the parents and the average scores are given in the next table and pie chart.


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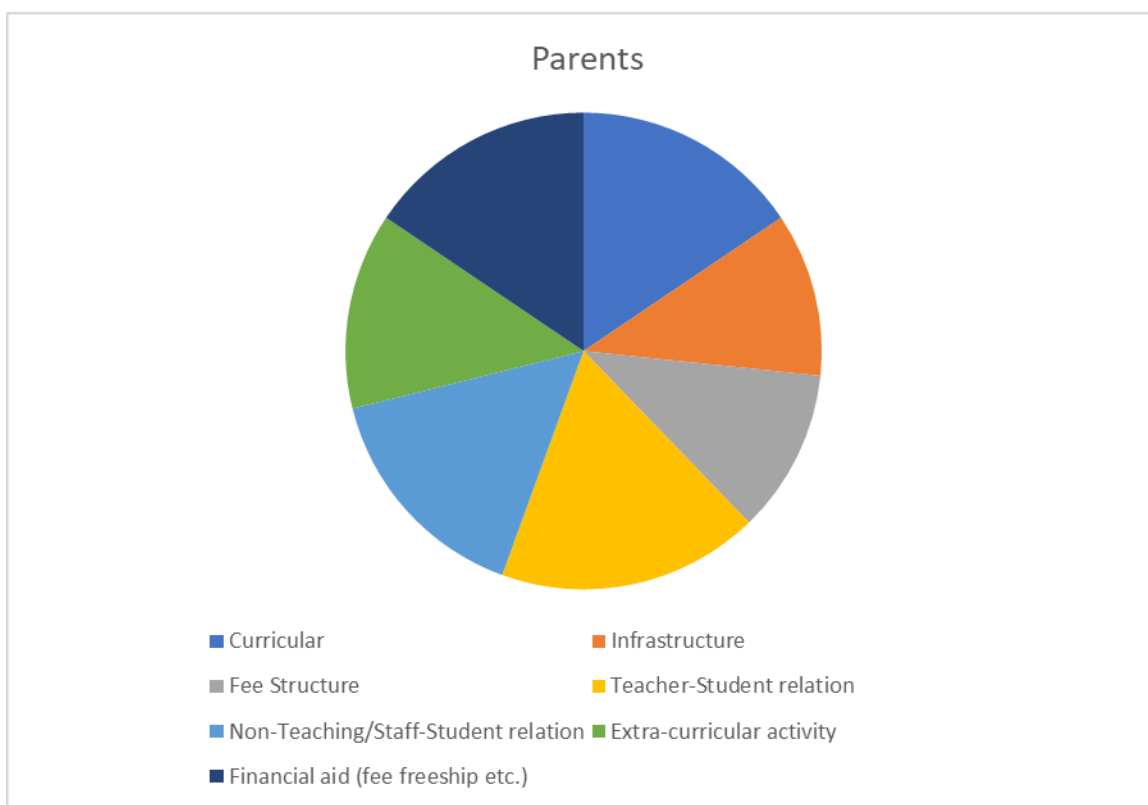

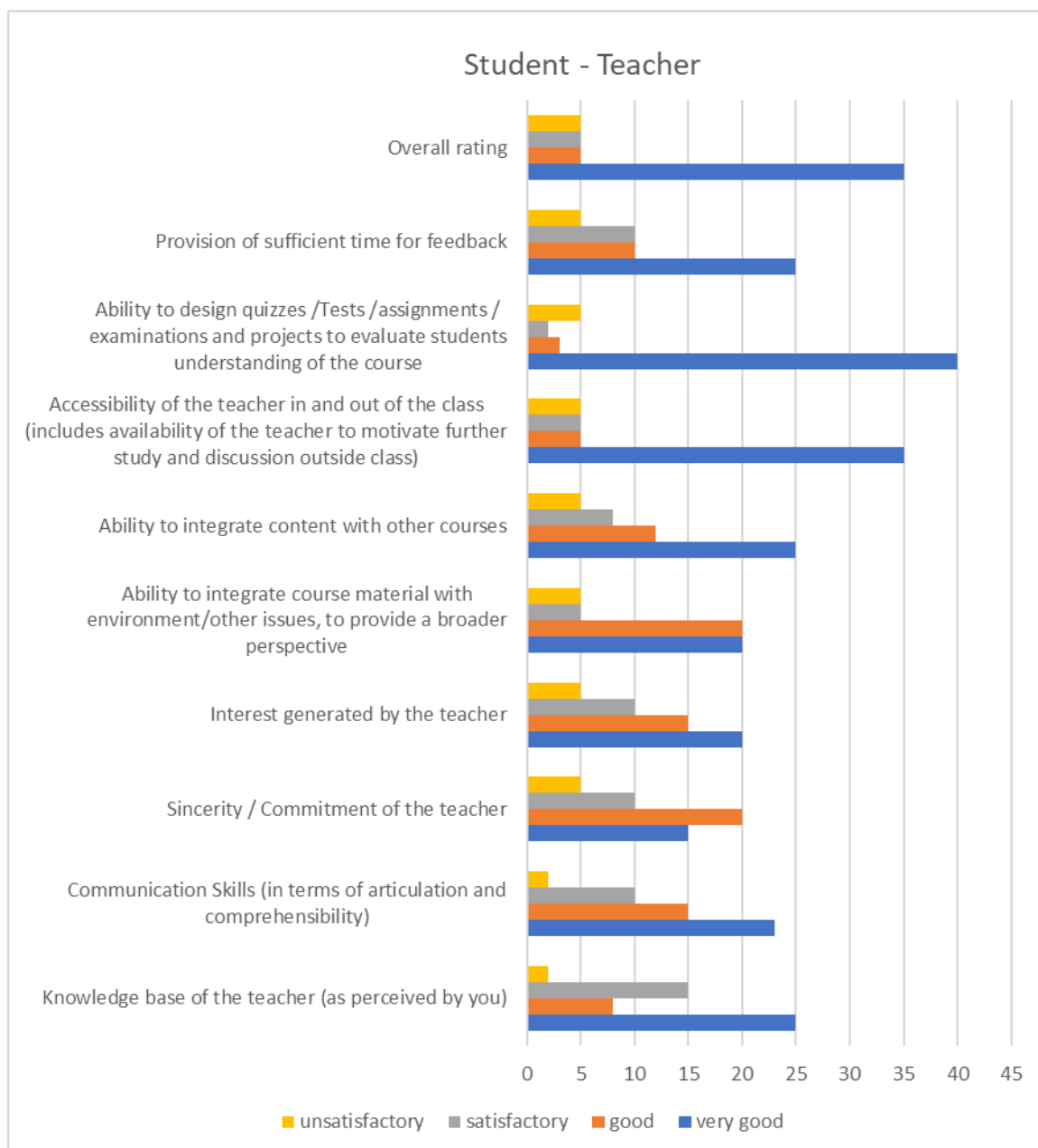

Following bar chart presents a summary of feedback for each item from the faculty and the average scores are given in the next table and pie chart.



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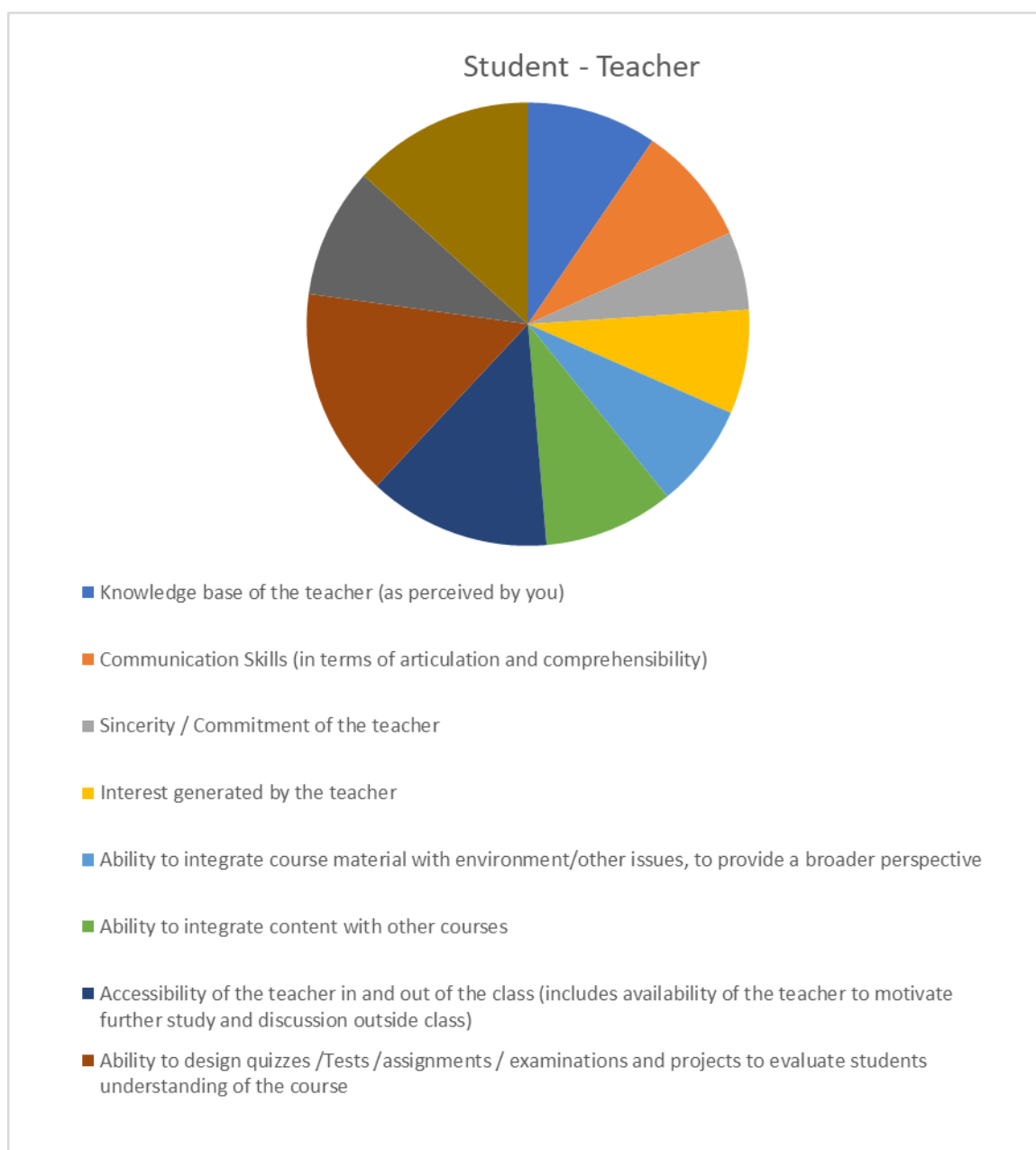

The average score received from teachers for this feedback 3.23.
